On October 23<sup>rd</sup> I Silvia Perez, owner of the business named as Erick's Jewelry Inc located at 18507 South Dixie Highway, Miami, Florida 33157 received a Certificate of Dissolution or Revocation at my house located at 17911 SW 143<sup>rd</sup> Court, Miami, Florida 33177. This letter states that we have not filed for the 2003 corporation annual report as required by law. This letter also requires a reinstatement fee of \$750.00. We immediately expressed our concern on this matter so we called the number cited in the letter for any inquiry related to this. Having spoken with the representative by the name of James who told us what to do. He suggested us to write this explanatory letter and send the check for \$ 150.00. Since we *had not* previously received a letter to file the annual report, Erick's Jewelry Inc as a young corporation and I personally as a citizen of the state of Florida request the necessary attention concerning this matter that affects us. We do not consider fair having to pay a reinstatement fee of such high amount due to an obvious *error* in the mailing process. We fully understand that this type of situation may occur anywhere so in order to keep up with the State's requirements in the Divisions of Corporations we have sent a check for \$150.00 which is the normal fee required by law.
