ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION INSIGHT PARTNERS, INC.

The undersigned, acting as Incorporators of a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby execute and acknowledge these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida:

- 1. Name. The name of the corporation shall be INSIGHT PARTNERS, INC.
- 2. Duration. The period of its duration is perpetual.
- 3. <u>Purpose</u>. The general purpose for which this corporation is organized is the transaction of any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the general corporation laws of the State of Florida, and any amendments thereto, and in connection therewith, this corporation shall have and may exercise any and all powers conferred from time to time by law upon corporations formed under such laws.
- 4. <u>Capital Stock</u>. The aggregate number of shares of capital stock authorized to be issued by this corporation shall be one thousand (1,000) shares, all of one class of common stock, at \$1.00 par value per share. Each share of said stock shall entitle the holder thereof to one vote at every annual or special meeting of the stockholders of this corporation. - 10. <u>Bylaws</u>. The power to adopt the by-laws of this corporation, to alter, amend or repeal the by-laws, or to adopt new by-laws, shall be vested in the Board of Directors of this corporation; provided, however, that any by-law or amendment thereto as adopted by the Board of Directors may be altered, amended or repealed by vote of the stockholders entitled to vote thereon, or a new by-law in lieu thereof may be adopted by vote of the stockholders. The corporation may be empowered by resolution of the Board of Directors to indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director, in the manner set out and provided for in the by-laws of the corporation, pursuant to the provisions of Section 607.0850 of the Florida Statutes, as amended.
- 13. <u>Informal Action of Directors</u>. If a majority of the Directors severally or collectively consent in writing to any action taken or to be taken by the corporation, and the writings evidencing their consent are filed with the Secretary of the corporation as part of the corporate records, the action shall be as valid as though it had been authorized at a meeting of the Board of Directors.
- 14. <u>Telephone Meetings</u>. Members of the Board of Directors shall be deemed present at a meeting if a conference telephone or similar communications equipment, by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can hear each other, is used.
- 15. <u>Informal Action of Shareholders</u>. Any action of the shareholders may be taken without a meeting if consent in writing setting forth the actions so taken shall be signed by the holders of outstanding stock having not less than the minimum number of votes that would be necessary to authorize or take such action at a meeting at which all shares entitled to vote thereon were present and voted, and filed with the Secretary of the corporation as part of the corporate records.
