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ARTICLES OF INCORPOARTION

ARTICLE 1: NAME AND MAILING ADDRESS

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The initial Bylaws shall be adopted by the Board of Directors. The power to alter, PM 12: 52 amend or repeal the Bylaws or adopt new Bylaws is vested in the Board of Directors subject to repeal or change by action of the shareholders.

ARTICLE 11: AMENDMENT

This Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment thereto, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.
