The undersigned natural person, who is licensed or otherwise legally authorized to practice the physician in the State of Florida, hereby gives notice of the intention of forming a professional corporation in accordance with the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, and hereby adopts the following articles of incorporation for such corporation:

**ARTICLE I - NAME**

The name of the corporation is: AMELIA M. BINDAS, Ph.D., P.A.

**ARTICLE II - DURATION**

The period of the corporation's duration shall be perpetual.

**ARTICLE III - PURPOSE**

The purpose of the corporation is to practice the profession of Industrial Psychology and Counseling. The sole and exclusive professional service to be rendered by the corporation is medical services.

#### **ARTICLE IX - DIRECTORS**

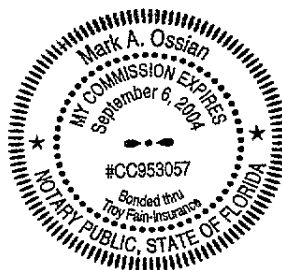
