ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

L & J DRUGS, INC.

The undersigned hereby makes, subscribes, and files these Articles for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida: $\frac{1}{2}$

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this corporation shall be L & J DRUGS, INC.

ARTICLE II

<u>Purpose</u>

This corporation is organized for the purpose of operating family pharmacies and for the purpose of transacting any or all lawful business.

ARTICLE III

Capital Stock

The capital stock of this corporation shall consist of 10,000 shares of common stock of \$1.00 par value, fully paid and non-assessable.

ARTICLE IV

Principal Office and Mailing Address

The Principal Office and the Mailing Address of this corporation is 115 South Dean Duff Avenue, Clewiston, FL 33440.

ARTICLE V

Registered Agent/Registered Office

ARTICLE VI

Initial Board of Directors

This corporation shall initially have one (1) Director. The number of Directors may be changed from time to time by the By-Laws but shall never be less than one (1). The name and address of the initial Director is:

ARTICLE VII

Special Provisions

The following special provisions shall govern this corporation:

- A. The time and place of the annual shareholders' meeting and the annual directors' meeting shall be fixed and provided for in the by-laws, and notice of same shall be given in one of the methods provided by law. Any shareholder or director may waive notice of the time, place and purpose of any meeting either before, at or after such meeting.
- B. There shall be a President, a Secretary and a Treasurer of this corporation, and such assistants as the shareholders may, by resolution, determine to

be necessary and/or as provided in the by-laws. This corporation may also have such other officers, assistants and factors as may be determined necessary and provided for by resolution of the shareholders and/or in the by-laws. Any person may hold two or more offices. The shareholders may, at any time, by majority vote at a duly-called and noticed meeting declare any office or directorship vacant or remove any officer or director and elect a successor thereto. Additionally, directors may, at any time, by majority vote at a duly-called and noticed meeting declare any office vacant or remove any officer and elect a successor thereto.

- C. The directors may describe a method or methods for replacement of lost certificates and prescribe reasonable conditions by way of security for the issuance of new certificates.
- D. No person shall be required to own, hold or control stock in the corporation as a condition precedent to holding an office or directorship in this corporation.
- E. No contract or other transaction between the corporation and any other corporation, in the absence of fraud, shall be affected or invalidated by the fact that any one or more of the officers or directors of the corporation is or are interested in or is an officer or director or are officers or directors of such other corporations, and any officer, officers or directors, individually or jointly, may be a party or parties to or may be interested in any such contract or transaction of the corporation or in which the corporation is interested, and no contract, act, or transaction of the corporation with any person or persons, firm or corporation, in the absence of fraud, shall be affected or invalidated by the fact that any officer, officers or directors of the corporation is a party

or parties to or interested in such contract, act or transaction, or in any way connected with such person or persons, firm or corporation, and each and every person who may become an officer or director of this corporation is hereby relieved from any liability that might otherwise exist from thus contracting with the corporation for the benefit of himself or any firm, association or corporation in which he may be in anywise interested.

F. Upon the proposed sale of any issued (or treasury) stock of this corporation, any holder of issued shares of this corporation of the same class or series shall have the right to purchase his prorata share of such unissued or treasury shares as are proposed for sale as nearly as may be done without the issuance of fractional shares at the price at which such shares are offered to others.
