

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF





ARTICLE I - CORPORATE NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be: PATRICIA M. ARIAS, P.A.

ARTICLE II - NATURE OF CORPORATE BUSINESS

This Corporation, through its officers and employees, shall be authorized to engage in every aspect of the practice of Law within the State of Florida and to engage in any activity which will facilitate and promote the practice of Law. Additionally, this Corporation shall have the authority to invest its funds in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds, and all other types of investments permitted by Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, as amended. This Corporation shall not be authorized to engage in any business other than the practice of Law and those activities permitted by Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, as amended.

ARTICLE III - DURATION

The Corporation shall have a perpetual existence. The Corporation shall commence existence on June 17, 2002.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

This Corporation is authorized to issue a maximum of One Hundred (100) shares of common stock having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share. The consideration to be paid for each share of stock shall be fixed by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V - INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE

The Corporation's initial Registered Agent and Registered Office in the State of Florida shall be: Patricia M. Arias, Esq., 2701 South Bayshore Drive, Suite 605, Miami, Florida 33173.

ARTICLE VI - MAILING ADDRESS OF CORPORATION

ARTICLE VII - INTIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

The number of Directors may be altered from time to time by By-Laws adopted by the Stockholders. However, the Corporation shall have no less than one (1) Director at any time. The name and post office address of the first Director, President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer of the Corporation is: Patricia M. Arias, Esq., 5975 Southwest 89th Avenue, Miami, Florida 33173.

ARTICLE VIII - INCORPORATOR

ARTICLE IX - APPLICABILITY OF PROVISIONS OF P ROFESSIONAL SERVICE CORPORATE ACT

This Corporation is organized to constitute a professional corporation as defined by the Professional Service Corporation Act, Florida Statutes, Chapter 621. Accordingly, this Corporation, its officers, directors and stockholders, shall be subject to all Sections of said Act concerning the formation of the Corporation, the conduct of its business and the liabilities, rights, privileges and immunities of the Corporation, its officers, directors and stockholders, as specified in Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, as amended.

ARTICLE X - SPECIAL PROVISION

It is the intent if the Incorporator that the corporation will qualify under section 1244 of the Internal Revenue Code and shall take all actions necessary to obtain and maintain its status as an S Corporation.

ARTICLE XI - INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall indemnify, to the full extent permitted by law, any officer, director, employee or agent of the Corporation, or any former officer, director, employee or agent of the Corporation is or was saving as a director, officer, employee or agent of another Corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise.

<u>ARTICLE XII - AMENDMENT</u>

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.
