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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION. OF FAMBUS, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation of the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. CORPORATE NAME.

The name of this Corporation is: FAMBUS, INC.

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS AND POWERS.

The Corporation shall have the power to engage in any lawful activity for which corporations may by organized under the Florida Business Corporation Act.


