SPECIAL PROVISIO

Any action by the directors of this corporation which is within their power taken at a meeting of such directors shall be valid for all intents and purposes whether or not lawful notice of said meeting shall have been given to all directors as required by law or by the By-Laws of this corporation, if at any time prior to, during or subsequent to such meeting all directors shall execute a waiver of notice of such meeting, in writing, and providing majority of the directors shall have approved or approve the action taken at such meeting.

When not prohibited by law, any action by the shareholders of the corporation which is within their power taken at a meeting shall have been given to all shareholders, as required by law or the By-Laws of this corporation, if at any time prior to, during or subsequent to such meeting all shareholders shall execute a waiver of notice of such meeting, in writing, and providing a majority of the shareholder shall have approved or approve the action taken at such meeting.

When not prohibited by law, any action of the shareholders of this corporation may be taken without a meeting if consent in writing, setting forth the action so taken, shall be signed by all the persons who would be entitled to vote upon such action at a meeting and filed with the secretary of the corporation as part of the corporate records. Nothing in this Article shall be construed to allow any act of the shareholders to be approved by less than a majority of said shareholders, or wherever a greater vote is required by law or in the By-Laws by that vote.

The actions of this corporation in obtaining funding and/or financing, establishing or terminating bank, brokerage or similar accounts, purchasing or transferring assets of the corporation or any other action of the corporation where signatures are required to bind the corporation shall require no less than two (2) signatures of the three (3) officers of the corporation, one (1) of which must be the President of the corporation or his duly authorized agent or attorney in fact as may be authorized under Florida law.

ARTICLE IX

INSPECTION OF BOOKS AND RECORDS
