ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

INSURANCE TECHNOLOGIES GROUP, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the provisions of Chapter 607, Fla.Stat., the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby states the following:

ARTICLE I - NAME AND ADDRESS

Section 1. The name of the Corporation shall be INSURANCE TECHNOLOGIES GROUP, INC.

Section 2. The initial principal office and the initial mailing address of the corporation shall be 399 N. Orange Street, PO Box 7, Ozona, Florida 34660.

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ARTICLE II - DURATION

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence beginning on the date these Articles are filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE AND POWERS

Section 1. The Corporation is formed for the purpose of engaging in any lawful activity or business for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida.

Section 2. The Corporation may exercise all powers, rights and privileges conferred on corporations pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

The authorized capital stock of the Corporation shall be Ten-thousand (10,000) shares of common stock, all of one class, having a par value of \$1.00 per share.

ARTICLE V - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1. The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors, the members of which shall be hereinafter referred to as Directors.

Section 2. The number of Directors shall be as provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation, but shall not be less than one (1).

Section 3. Directors shall be elected and hold office as provided in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VI - BYLAWS

Section 1. The Board of Directors shall adopt Bylaws for the Corporation at a meeting of the Board of Directors following the filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

Section 2. The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal the Bylaws of the Colpolation may be exercised by the Board of Directors of the stockholders in accordance with the provisions of the Bylaws.

Section 3. Any Bylaws adopted by the Board of Directors or the stockholders may be altered, amended or repealed by the other group; provided, however, that any Bylaw adopted by the stockholders may provide that it shall be altered, amended, or repealed only by the stockholders.

ARTICLE VII - REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

Section 1. The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation shall be 399 Orange Street, Ozona, Florida 34660...
