

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural personning competent to contract, hereby forms a professional corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

# ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation is BRODSKY & MULLIN, P.A.

# ARTICLE II DURATION AND BEGINNING OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

The corporation shall exist perpetually. The date when the corporate existence of this corporation shall begin shall be upon the date of filing of these Articles with the Secretary of State.

# ARTICLE III NATURE OF BUSINESS


