ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OZJUL ZO PM 1:10 WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, hereby associate ourselves together the purpose of becoming a corporation under the laws of the state of Florida, providing for the formation, liability, rights, privileges and immunities of corporations for profit.
