ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE ONE - NAME

ARTICLE THREE- SHARES

CAPITAL STOCK. ARTICLE ELEVEN - INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS


The initial Board of Directors shall consist of one member, who shall be:

No person falling within the Preview of the foregoing sentence may apply for indemnification or advancement of expenses to any court of competent jurisdiction.
