ARTICLES OF CORPORATION

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U.S. ORCA, INC.

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this corporation is:

U.S. ORCA, INC.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation is to exist perpetually. It shall commence its existence upon filing.

ARTICLE III – PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any or all business permitted under the laws of the United States of America and the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue 1,000 shares of No Par Value Common Stock.

Shares may be issued for such consideration as it is determined from time to time by the shareholders.

This power which is hereby reserved unto the stockholders by right may, and it is hereby delegated, unto the Board of Directors.
