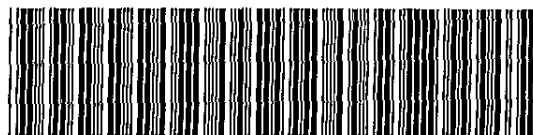

The name of the Corporation ("Corporation") is Julian Alexander & Associates of Palm Beach, Inc.


ARTICLE II
