A Corporation for profit formed under the Florida General Corporation Act.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, is a natural person competent to contract and hereby form a Corporation for profit under Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II - ADDRESS

The initial principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

The board of Directors may from time to time move the principal office to any other address in Florida.

ARTICLE III - TERM OF EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV - PURPOSE

The general nature of the business and business to be transacted are as follows: To transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Laws of the State of Florida of the United States. Without in any way limiting any of the objects and powers of the Corporation, it is expressly declared and provided that the Corporation, to carry on its business, or for the purpose of accomplishing any of the objects hereinabove mentioned, shall have the power to make and perform contracts of any kind
