ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, being duly licensed to practice law under the laws of the State of Florida, adopts these articles to form a corporation under the Professional Service Corporation Act, Florida Statutes Chapter 621, and other laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME
