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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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COMPLEMENTARY ALTERNATIVE MEDICINE EDUCATIONAL SECRETARY OF STATE

The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, are natural ASSEE, FLORIDA persons, competent, and hereby form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is: Complementary Alternative Medicine Educational Services Corporation.

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

The corporation shall have the unlimited power to engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States of America and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock the corporation shall have authority to issue is one thousand (1,000) shares of Common Stock having a par value of \$1.00 each.

ARTICLE VI. PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

Each stockholder of the corporation shall have the right to purchase, subscribe for, or receive a right or rights to purchase or subscribe for, at the par value thereof, a pro rata portion of:

- (i) Any stock of any class that the corporation may issue or sell, whether or not exchangeable for any stock of the corporation of any class or classes, and whether issued for cash, labor done, personal property, or real property or leases therof: or
- (ii) Any obligation that the corporation may issue or sell which is convertible into or exchangeable for any stock of the corporation of any class or classes, or to which is attached or pertinent any warrant or warrants or other instruments conferring on the holder the right to subscribe for or purchase from the corporation any shares of its stock of any class or classes.

ARTICLE VII. MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATION BY STOCKHOLDERS

The corporation shall have no board of directors, and all of the corporate powers shall be exercised by, and the business and affairs of the corporation shall be managed under the direction of stockholders.

ARTICLE VIII. STOCK TRANSFERS-CORPORATION'S RIGHT OF FIRST REFUSAL

No stockholder shall have the right to sell, assign, pledge, encumber, transfer, or otherwise dispose of any of the shares of the corporation without first offering such shares for sale to the corporation without first offering such shares for sale to the corporation at the net asset value thereof. Such offer shall be in writing, signed by the stockholder; shall be registered or certified mail to the corporation for a period of ninety days for the date of mailing. If the corporation fails or refuses within each period to make satisfactory arrangements for the purchase of such shares, the stockholder shall have the right to dispose of his shares as he may see fit.

On the death of any stockholder, the corporation shall have the right to purchase all shares owned by such stockholder immediately prior to his death on the terms set forth above, and this provision shall be binding on the executor, administrator, or personal representative of each stockholder.

Each share certificate issued by the corporation shall have printed or stamped thereof the following legend: "These shares are held subject to certain transfer

restrictions imposed by the Articles of Incorporation of the corporation. A copy of such articles is on file at the principle office of the corporation."
