# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

#### REALTOR ASSOCIATES OF FLORIDA, INC.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person commetent to contract, hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the state of Florida.

#### · ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: REALTOR ASSOCIATES OF FLORIDA. INC.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be at 5881 NW 151 Street, Suite 103. Miami, Florida 33014.

#### ARTICLE IL NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation may engage or transact in any or all lawful activities or business permitted. under the laws of the United States; the State of Florida or any other state, country, territory or nation including, but not limited to performing the services of a Florida Licensed Real Estate Broker pursuant to Chapter 475 Florida Statutes.

#### ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have oujstanding at any one time is 1,000 shares of common stock along no per value per abare.

## ARTICLE VIII - INDEMNIFICATION

A. Indemnity. The corporation shall indemnify any person who was or is a party or is threatened to be made a party to any threatened, pending or contemplated action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative, by reason of the fact that he is or was a director, employee, officer or agent of the Corporation, against all expenses (including attorneys' fees and appellate attorneys' fees), judgments, times and amounts paid in settlement actually and reasonably incurred by him in connection with such action, suit or proceeding, unless (a) a court of competent jurisdiction finally determines, after all appeals have been exhausted or not pursued by

the proposed indemnites, that he did not act in good faith or in a manner he reasonably believed to be in or not opposed to the best interest of the corporation and, with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, that he had reasonable cause to believe his conduct was unlawful, and (b) such court also determines specifically that indemnification should be dealed. The tempination of any action, suit or proceeding by judgment, order, settlement, conviction or upon a plea of nolo contenders or its equivalent shall not, of itself, create a presumption that the person did not act in good faith and in a manner which he reasonably believed to be in or not opposed to the best interest of the corporation, and with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, had reasonable cause to believe that his conduct was unlawful.

E. Expenses. To the extent that a director, officer, employed or agent of the corporation has been successful on the merits or otherwise in defense of any action, suit or proceeding referred to in Section VIII A. above, or in defense of any claim, issue or matter therein, he shall be indemnified against all expenses (including automorph) fees and appellate attorneys' fees) actually and reasonably incurred by him in connection therewith.

C. Advances. All expenses incurred in defending a civil or oriminal action, suit or proceeding shall be paid by the corporation in advance of the final disposition of such action, suit or proceeding upon receipt of an undertaking by or on behalf of the affected director, officer, employee or agent to repay such amount unless it shall ultimately be determined that he is entitled to be indemnified by the corporation as authorized in this Article VIII.

D. Miscellaneous. The indemnification provided by this Article shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which those seeking indemnification may be entitled under any by-

law agreement, vote of directors, shareholders or otherwise, and shall continue as to a person who has ceased to be a director, officer, employee or agent and shall inure to the banefit of the hairs and personal representatives of such person.

E. Ipsurance. The corporation shall have the power to purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of any person who is or was a director, officer, employer or agent of the corporation, or is or was serving, at the request of the corporation, as a director, officer, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise, against any liability asserted against blim and incurred by him in any such capacity, or arising out of his status as such, whether or not the corporation would have the power to indemnify him against such liability under the provisions of this Article.

F. Amendment. Anything to the contrary herein notwithstanding, the provisions of this Article VIII may not be amended without the approval in writing of all persons whose interest would be adversely affected by such amendment.
