**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
**OF**

The undersigned, desiring to form a for profit corporation under the Corporation Law of Florida, Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes, hereby certifies:

**ARTICLE I – NAME**

The name of the Corporation shall be K-CAMP, INC.

**ARTICLE II – PRINCIPAL OFFICE**

The principal office of the Corporation is located at C/O Erik Edward Joh, P.A., 4600 N. Ocean Blvd., Suite 206, Boynton Beach, Florida 33435, and Palm Beach County.
