Dear Mr. Scott:

I have talked to you in the past about getting a corporation reinstated. You told me that the Secretary of State would consider reinstatement without the penalty if the forms were never received.

I am the accountant for Christians Creek Growers, Inc., [corporation] a corporation organized on September 2, 2002. I noted today when I checked the Division of Corporation's website that the annual fees had not been paid by the corporation since 2003. Mr. William Nash was not aware that the corporation had been administratively dissolved until I brought it to his attention.

When I questioned Mr. Nash about his receiving the UBR that the State of Florida mailed to him in early January 2003, he stated he never received the form. Since Mr. Nash travels extensively and he never received the UBR for 2003, we are requesting an abatement of the late filing fees and asking that the corporation be reinstated for the payment of the 2003, 2004, and 2005 fees only in the amount of \$150 for each year or a total of \$450.00.

The corporation has enclosed its check in the amount of \$450.00 made payable to the Department of State to reinstate the corporation and pay the annual fees for 2003, 2004, and 2005 ---- which is due by May 1, 2005. Thank again for your assistance.
