ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

J.C. FULLER & ASSOCIATES, P.A.



THE UNDERSIGNED subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, being duly licensed to practice law under the laws of the state of Florida, adopts these Articles to form a Corporation under the Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 621, and other laws of the state of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the professional service corporation is J.C. FULLER & ASSOCIATES, P.A.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation is 1412 Noble Street; Longwood, FL 32750.

ARTICLE III - SPECIFIC PURPOSE

The specific purpose of this Professional Service Corporation is to engage in every aspect of the practice of law. In addition, the corporation may invest the funds of the professional service corporation in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds, or any other type of investment, and own real and personal property necessary for the rendering of professional services.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

The capital stock of the professional service corporation shall be One Thousand (1000) shares of common stock having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share. None of the shares of the professional service corporation may be issued to anyone other than an individual duly licensed to practice law in the state of Florida.

ARTICLE V - TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI - DIRECTORS

The business of the professional service corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of one (1) member. The number of Directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by the Bylaws, provided it shall never be less than one. All Directors must be duly licensed to practice law in the state of Florida. The name and address of the member of the initial Board of Directors is: JOYCE C. ARTICLE VII - INCORPORATOR/SUBSCRIBER

ARTICLE VIII - RESTRAINT ON ALIENATION OF SHARES

The shareholders of the professional service corporation shall have the power to include in the bylaws or by separate agreement adopted by a majority of the shareholders of the professional service corporation, any regulatory or restrictive provisions regarding the proposed sale, transfer, or other disposition of any of the outstanding stock of the professional service corporation by any of its shareholders, or in the event of the death of any of its shareholders. The manner and form, as well as the relevant terms, conditions, and details, of the disposition shall be determined by the shareholders of the professional service corporation. No shareholder of the professional service corporation except to another individual who is eligible to be a shareholder of the professional service corporation, and the sale or transfer may be made only after it has been approved at a shareholder meeting especially called for that purpose. If any shareholder becomes legally disqualified to practice law in the state of Florida, is elected to a public office, or accepts employment that places restrictions or limitations on the continuous rendering of such professional services, that shareholder's shares of stock shall immediately become subject to purchase by the professional service corporation in accordance with the bylaws adopted by the shareholders.

ARTICLE IX - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is: 1412 Noble Street, Longwood, Florida 32750; and the name of the initial registered agent of this corporation at that address is: Joyce C. Fuller.

ARTICLE X - EFFECTIVE DATE

These Articles of Incorporation shall become effective upon filing with the Florida Secretary of State.

ARTICLE XI - BYLAWS

The initial Bylaws shall be adopted by the initial Board of Directors. Thereafter they shall be amended or altered in the manner provided for in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE XII - AMENDMENT

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law. Every amendment shall be approved by the majority vote of qualified shareholders at a duly noticed

shareholder's meeting called for that purpose, unless all of the shareholders sign a written statement manifesting their intention that a certain amendment of the Articles of Incorporation be made.
