# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF AMERICAN GLASS LAMINATES, INCORPORATED

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

# ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

AMERICAN GLASS LAMINATES, INCORPORATED

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be 4800 N. Federal Highway, Suite 307B, Boca Raton, Florida 33431.

### ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation may engage in or transact any or all lawful activities or business permitted under the laws of the United States, the State of Florida, or any other state, country, territory or nation, including, but not limited to business and real estate investment.

### ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK

The aggregate number of shares of stock and its par value that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is:

1000 shares \$1.00 par value

### ARTICLE IV. TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation is to exist perpetually.

# ARTICLE V. REGISTERED AGENT & ADDRESS

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation shall be 4800 N. Federal Highway, Suite 307-B, Boca Raton, FL 33431, and the name of the initial registered agent of the corporation at that address is CAP Service Corporation.

# ARTICLE VI. OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

This corporation shall have one (1) director, initially. The name and street address of the initial Officer and Director who shall hold office for the first year of the corporation, or until their successor(s) are elected or appointed are:

Directors shall serve for a term of one (1) year, until the annual meeting of stockholders following the election of Directors and until the qualifications of their successors in office has been established. Any certificate or other document filed under any provision of law which relates to action so taken shall state that the action was taken by unanimous written consent of the Board of Directors without a meeting, and that the Articles of Incorporation and the By-Laws of this corporation authorize the Directors to so act. Such a statement shall be prima facie evidence of such authority.

# ARTICLE VIII. AMENDMENT OF BY-LAWS

Subject to the limitations contained in the By-Laws, the By-Laws of this corporation may be made, altered, rescinded, added to, or new By-Laws may be adopted, either by a unanimous resolution of the Board of Directors, or by following the procedure set forth therefor in the By-Laws.
