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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
EDUCATION GUIDE OF AMERICA, INC.**

ARTICLE I

Name and Duration

The name of the Corporation is Education Guide of America, Inc. The duration of the Corporation is perpetual. This Corporation shall begin its corporate existence as of the date that these Articles are filed by the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE II

Principal Office

The address of the principal office and mailing address of the Corporation in the State of Florida is 1510-A South Second Street, Jacksonville Beach, FL 32250.

ARTICLE III

Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the registered office in the State of Florida is 50 North Laura Street, Suite 2500, Jacksonville, FL 32202 in the County of Duval. The name of the registered agent at such address is Motolaw, Inc..

ARTICLE IV

Corporate Purposes, Powers and Rights

1. The nature of the business to be conducted or promoted and the purposes of the Corporation are to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Florida Business Corporation Act.

2. In furtherance of its corporate purposes, the Corporation shall have all of the general and specific powers and rights granted to and conferred on a corporation by the Florida Business Corporation Act.

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ARTICLE VCapital Stock

The total number of shares of capital stock which the Corporation has the authority to issue is one hundred thousand (100,000) shares of Common Stock ("Common Stock") no par value per share.

ARTICLE VIIBoard of Directors

1. The number of members of the Board of Directors may be increased or diminished from time to time by the Bylaws; provided, however, there shall never be less than one. Each director shall serve until the next annual meeting of shareholders.

2. If any vacancy occurs in the Board of Directors during a term, the remaining directors, by affirmative vote of a majority thereof, may elect a director to fill the vacancy until the next annual meeting of shareholders.

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation, in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute, and all rights conferred upon shareholders herein are granted subject to this reservation.

ARTICLE IX

Bylaws

The power to adopt, amend or repeal bylaws for the management of this Corporation shall be vested in the Board of Directors or the shareholders, but the Board of Directors may not amend or repeal any bylaw adopted by the shareholders if the shareholders specifically provide that such bylaw is not subject to amendment or repeal by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE X

Indemnification

The Corporation shall indemnify any incorporator, officer or director, or any former incorporator, officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE XI

Transfer of Shares

If, from time to time, a shareholders' agreement among all of the shareholders of the Corporation is in effect regarding the Subchapter S status of the Corporation pursuant to the Internal Revenue Code of the United States in effect from time to time, then transfers of the Corporation's Common Stock made not in accordance with such agreement, whether by operation of law or otherwise, are null and void ab initio.
