ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF IMELDA USA, INC.

Pursuant to the Florida Business Corporation Act, Article III of the Articles of Incorporation of IMELDA USA, INC., a Florida corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation", is amended to read as follows:

"ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK:
