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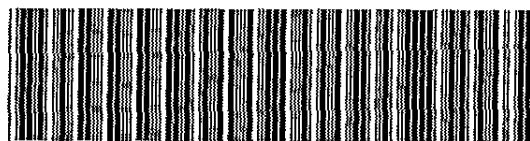

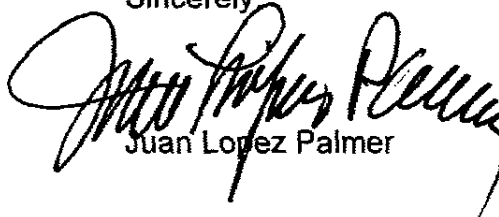

In compliance with the requirements of F.S. Chapter 617, the undersigned, being a natural person, hereby acts as an incorporator in adopting and filing the following articles of incorporation for the purpose of organizing a Not For Profit Corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation ("Corporation") is Pro Rights Committee, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The existence of the Corporation shall begin on the date these Articles of Incorporation are filed in the Department of State.

ARTICLE III

The street address of the principal office of the Corporation is 1703 Club Circle, Lakeshore, Florida 33854; and the mailing address of the corporation is Post Office Box 388, Lake Wales, Florida 33853.

ARTICLE IV

The Corporation is organized for the purpose of operating a residential community in the State of Florida, provide procedures to operate a homeowners' association, and to protect the rights of such homeowners' association members.

ARTICLE V

The initial street address of the Corporation's registered office is 1703 Club Circle, Lakeshore, Florida 33854. The initial registered agent for the Corporation at that address is Eduardo Molina.

ARTICLE VI
