## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NORTH POINTE LEARNING ACADEMY 1N° .

The undersigned incorporator delivers these Articles of Incorporation in order to form a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act.

### ARTICLE I Name and Principal Office

The name of the Corporation shall be NORTH POINTE LEARNING ACADEMY INC. The address of the principal office of the corporation shall be 14706 North Boulevard, Tampa, FL 33613.

### ARTICLE II Corporate Purposes, Power and Rights

The purpose of the Corporation is to engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

#### ARTICLE III Duration of the Corporation

Existence of the Corporation shall commence on the date all fees are paid and these Articles of Incorporation are filed by the Secretary of State and the Corporation shall exist perpetually unless dissolved according to law.
