ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

The undersigned incorporators of these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person competent to contract, hereby associate themselves together to form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation is:

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is to operate an importing business; and to engage in every and any aspect and phase of any and every lawful business, including, but not limited to, the following activities:
