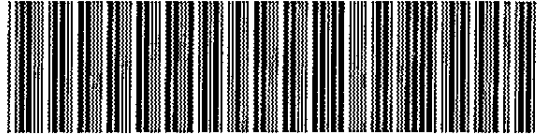

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of the corporation shall be SAND MAN TRUCKING, INC.

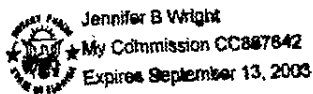


