ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PAPA JOE'S OF METROWEST, INC

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation is: Papa Joe's of MetroWest, Inc.

ARITCLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

The Corporation may engage in any activities or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

In addition, the corporation can invest in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds, or any other type of investment and can own real and personal property.

ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time shall be as follows: Five Hundred (500) shares of IRS Section 1244 common stock having a par value of \$1.00 per share. ARTICLE VI. ADDRESS

ARTICLE VII. DIRECTORS
