ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SECRETARIAT STABLES, INC.

The undersigned, being of legal age and competent to contract, for the purpose of organizing a corporation pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation, and does hereby agree and certify as follows:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be: SECRETARIAT STABLES, INC.

ARTICLE II. COMMENCEMENT OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall commence corporate existence December 12, 2002, and shall have perpetual existence unless sooner dissolved according to law.
