ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ALA-FLA COTTON GROWERS, INC.

The undersigned subscribers to these Articles, natural persons competent to contract, hereby form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, and under the following articles:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Ala-Fla Cotton Growers, Inc.

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation shall not conduct a banking, safe deposit, trust, insurance, surety, express, railroad, canal, telegraph, telephone, or cemetery company or a building and loan association, fraternal benefit society, or a State Fair or Exposition. Subject to such limitations, it shall engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of this United States or the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 10,000 shares of common stock having a nominal par value of \$1.00 per share.

ARTICLE IV. TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the corporation's initial registered office is 15 West La Rua St., Pensacola, Florida 32501, and the name of the initial registered agent of this corporation is Steven J. Baker.

ARTICLE VI. DIRECTORS

The business of the corporation shall be managed and its corporate powers exercised by a Board of one or more directors. The corporation shall have One (1) director initially. The number of directors may be increased or deceased from time to time by-laws adopted by the stockholders, but there shall never be less than one.

ARTICLE VII. INITIAL DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

ARTICLES IX. RESTRICTION ON SALE OF STOCK

The corporation and, subject to the priority of the corporation, the remaining stockholders of the corporation shall have preference in the purchase of any shares of capital stock of the corporation and any attempted sale of such shares of stock in violation of this provision shall be null and void. In case a stockholder, his or her personal representative, heirs, devisees, legatees, pledges, assignees, receivers, trustee in bankruptcy, or any other person holding under or in privity with any stockholder, desires to sell his or her shares of stock, he or she shall file notice in writing of such intention with the president of the corporation stating the terms of such bona fide offer which he or she has received, and unless the terms of such offer are accepted by the corporation within ten (10) days, it

shall be deemed to have waived its privilege of purchasing. In the event the corporation is legally unable to purchase such stock or otherwise waives its privilege of purchasing, the president of the corporation shall mail written notice to all remaining stockholders, by certified mail, return receipt requested, advising them of the terms of such bona fide offer, and unless the terms of such offer are accepted by any or all of the other stockholders within ten (10) days from the date of mailing such notice, they shall be deemed to have waived their privilege of purchasing, and the stockholder, or the person in privity with him or her, desiring to sell shall be at liberty to effect a sale upon the terms of such bona fide offer. No stockholder may cause the corporation or the remaining stockholders to waive their privilege of purchasing until such stockholder has received a bona fide offer for the purchase of such shares. Neither the corporation nor the remaining stockholders, (collectively), may exercise their privilege of purchasing as to any shares of stock less than the total number of shares involved in such bona fide offer.

ARTICLE X. INDEMNIFICATION

The corporation shall indemnify any officer or director or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE XI. AMENDMENT

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, by a majority vote of the Board of Directors, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.


