We contacted your office immediately afterward and were told to download the Corporation Reinstatement form, complete it, check the box certifying that we did not receive any notices, and send in a check in the amount of \$600.00 to reinstate (thereby paying for 2004, 2005, 2006, and 2007).


We received a letter in return (copy enclosed) with our check enclosed. The letter says we owe \$1200.00, then it says \$1050.00 (because the 2004 payment **was** received).

Today, we again contacted your office and we were told to resubmit our paperwork with a check in the amount of \$450.00 as the \$150.00 fee was paid in 2004 but your office sent a rejection letter noting that our FEIN was missing. We never received your rejection letter. The lady that we spoke today was Debra. She was very helpful and explained what had apparently happened. She said that a supervisor would review our paperwork when it arrives.

We are asking that you waive the reinstatement fee because we never received your rejection letter.
