ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TROPICAL ASPHALT MANAGEMENT, INC.

The undersigned subscriber of these Articles of Incorporation is a natural person competent to contract and hereby form a Corporation for profit under Chapter 607of the Florida Statutes.

<u>ARTICLE 1 – NAME</u>

The name of the Corporation is **TROPICAL ASPHALT MANAGEMENT**, **INC.**, (hereinafter, "Corporation")

ARTICLE 2 - PURPOSE OF BUSINESS

ARTICLE 7 - CORPORATE CAPITALIZATION

- 7.1 The maximum number of shares that this Corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (7,500) shares of common stock, each having the par value of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00).
- 7.2 All holders of shares of common stock shall be identical with each other in every respect and the holders of common shares shall be entitled to have unlimited voting rights on all shares and be entitled to one vote for each share on all matters on which Shareholders have the right to vote.
- 7.3 All holders of shares of common stock, upon the dissolution of the Corporation, shall be entitled to receive the net assets of the Corporation.
- 7.4 No holder of shares of stock of any class shall have any preemptive right to subscribe to or purchase any additional shares of any class, or any bonds or convertible securities of any nature; provided, however, that the Board of Director(s) may, in authorizing the issuance of shares of stock of any class, confer any preemptive right that the Board of Director(s) may deem advisable in connection with such issuance.
- 7.5 The Board of Director(s) of the Corporation may authorize the issuance from time to time of shares of its stock of any class, whether now or hereafter authorized, or securities convertible into shares of its stock of any class, whether now or hereafter authorized, for such consideration as the Board of Director(s) may deem advisable, subject to such restrictions or limitations, if any, as may be set forth in the bylaws of the Corporation.

"The shares of stock represented by this certificate cannot be transferred if such transfer would void the election of the Corporation to be taxed under Sub-Chapter S of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended."

ARTICLE 9 - SHAREHOLDERS' RESTRICTIVE AGREEMENT

All of the share of stock of this Corporation may be subject to a Shareholders' Restrictive Agreement containing numerous restrictions on the rights of shareholders of the Corporation and transferability of the shares of stock of the Corporation. A copy of the Shareholders' Restrictive Agreement, if any, is on file at the principal office of the Corporation.

<u>ARTICLE 10 – POWERS OF CORPORATION</u>

The Corporation shall have the same powers as an individual to do all things necessary or convenient to carry out its business and affair, subject to any limitations or restrictions imposed by applicable law or these Articles of Incorporation.
