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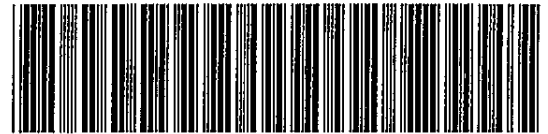



**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

THE UNDERSIGNED Incorporator, to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this corporation is Osmosis Productions, Inc.



This corporation may indemnify and insure its officers and directors to the fullest extent permitted by law.


