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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I

Name and Duration

The name of the Corporation is DELMAR LOGISTICS (FL) INC. The duration of the Corporation is perpetual. The Corporation shall begin its corporate existence as of the date that these Articles are filed by the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE II

Corporate Purposes, Powers and Rights

- 1. The nature of the business to be conducted or promoted and the purposes of the Corporation are to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Florida Business Corporation Act, including, but not limited to: The operation of a customs brokerage business, to assist and aid importers and exporters to move merchandise through U.S. Customs, providing the proper paperwork and payments to U.S. Customs for clients, and charge a fee for those services, including services in areas such as entry, admissibility, classification, valuation, rates of duty, and fees on imported merchandise; provided that the Corporation obtains and maintains a broker license to transact customs business and at least one officer who is individually licensed who will qualify the Corporation's license.
- 2. In furtherance of its corporate purposes, the Corporation shall have all of the general and specific powers and rights granted to and conferred on a corporation by the Florida Business Corporation Act.

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ARTICLE V

Capital Stock

The total number of shares of capital stock which the Corporation has the authority to issue is three thousand (3,000) shares of Common Stock ("Common Stock") having no par value per share.
