

The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, natural persons competent to contract, hereby form this corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

# ARTICLE I

## NAME

The name of this corporation is O-A-R DEVELOPMENT, INC...

# ARTICLE II

# NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of this State.

## ARTICLE III

## CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is ten thousand (10,000) shares of common stock having a nominal par value of One Dollar (\$1.00).

#### ARTICLE IV

#### ARTICLE X

## TRANSFERABILITY OF SHARES

Any and all of the stockholders of this corporation may from time to time enter into such agreement as may seem expedient to them, relating to the shares of stock held by them, and limiting the transferability thereof; and thereafter any transfer of said shares shall be made in accordance with the terms of said agreement provided that before the actual transfer of said shares on the books of the corporation, written notice of such agreement shall be given to this corporation by filing a copy thereof with the Secretary of the corporation, and a reference to such agreement noted upon the certificate representing said shares, and by the By-Laws of this corporation shall likewise include proper provisions for the making of such agreements as aforesaid.

## ARTICLE XI

#### PRE-EMPTIVE RIGHTS

Each stockholder of the corporation shall have the right to purchase or subscribe for, at the par value thereof, a pro rata portion of:

(1) Any stock of any class that the corporation may issue or sell, whether or not

exchangeable for any stock of the corporation acquired by it after the issuance thereof, and whether issued for cash, labor done, personal property, or real property or leases thereof; or

(2) Any obligation that the corporation may issue or sell which is convertible into or exchangeable for any stock of the corporation of any class or classes, or to which is attached or pertinent to any warrant or warrants or other instrument or instruments conferring on the holder the right to subscribe for or purchase from the corporation any shares of its stock of any class or classes.

#### ARTICLE XII

# **CUMULATIVE VOTING RIGHTS**

The principal of cumulative voting shall apply in all elections of directors of the corporation. Each stockholder entitled to vote shall have votes equal to the number of shares with voting rights held by him multiplied by the number of directors to be elected, and each may cast all of his votes for a single candidate or may divide and distribute his votes among any two or more candidates, as he may see fit. Each stockholder may, if he desires, cast fewer than all the votes to which he is entitled to an election of directors, but no ballot shall be valid if the total votes shown thereon are in excess of the total number of votes to which the stockholder casting such ballot is entitled.

At any such election, the candidates receiving the highest number of votes, up to the number of directors to be chosen, shall be elected, and an absolute majority of the votes cast is not a prerequisite to the election of any candidate to the Board of Directors.

#### ARTICLE XIII

## TRANSACTIONS WITH INTERESTED DIRECTORS OR OFFICERS

In the absence of fraud, no contract or other transactions between this corporation and any other corporation or any individual or firm shall be in any way affected or invalidated by the fact that any of the directors or officers of this corporation are interested in such contract or transaction; provided that such interest shall be fully disclosed or otherwise known to the Board of Directors in the meeting of said Board of Directors at which such contract or transaction is authorized or confirmed; and provided further, that any such directors of this corporation who are so interested may be counted

in determining the existence of a quorum at any meeting of the Board of Directors of this corporation which shall authorize any such contract or transaction with like force and effect as if he were not such director or officer of such other corporation or not so interested.

#### ARTICLE XIV

# **DIRECTORS - INDEMNIFICATION**

The corporation shall indemnify any person who was or is a party or is threatened to be made a party to any threatened, pending, or completed action, suit, or proceedings, whether civil or criminal, administrative or investigative, by reason of the fact that he is or was a director, officer, employee, or agent of the corporation, or is or was serving at the request of the corporation as a director, officer, employee, or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, or other enterprise against expenses (including attorney's fees), judgments, fines, and amounts paid in connection with such action, suit, or proceeding, including any appeal thereof, if he acted in good faith or in a manner he reasonably believed to be in or not opposed to the best interests of the corporation, and with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, if he had no reasonable cause to believe his conduct was unlawful. However, with respect to any action by or in the right of the corporation to procure a judgment in its favor, no indemnification shall be made in respect of any claim, issue, or matter as to which such person is adjudged liable for negligence or misconduct in the performance of his duty to the corporation unless, and only to the extent that, the court in which such action or suit was brought determines, on application, that despite the adjudication of liability, such person is fairly and reasonably entitled to indemnity in view of all the circumstances of the case. Any indemnification hereunder shall be made only on a determination by a majority of disinterested directors (subject to the approval of a majority of stockholders) that indemnification is proper in the particular circumstances the nature and status at the time of such payment of the litigations or threatened litigations.

## ARTICLE XV

## REPLACEMENT OF STOCK CERTIFICATES

The Board of Directors may, by resolution, provide for the issuance of stock certificates to

replace lost or destroyed certificates.

# ARTICLE XVI

# AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law. Every amendment shall be approved at a stockholders' meeting by a majority of the stock entitled to vote thereon.
