The undersigned Incorporator, being a person competent to contract, subscribes to these Wittibles of DA Incorporation to form a Corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be HealthFair International, Inc.

ARTICLE II - BUSINESS AND ACTIVITIES

This Corporation is authorized to engage for operation as business intermediaries as permitted and under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK
