
Subject: REQUEST FOR ABATEMENT OF REINSTATEMENT FEE

Dear Sir or Madam:

Our client, Mr. Christopher Swartz recently discovered that his corporation, Level Zero Communications, Inc. is listed as inactive according to your records. He never received notification about filing the annual report form and payment of the annual fee because the notice was mailed to his old address. Attached is his check for \$300 for the 2004 and 2005 annual fees. We request an abatement of the \$600 reinstatement fee based on the facts and circumstances listed below.

Level Zero Communications, Inc. filed articles of incorporation on June 9, 2003 showing its address as 2550 Lake Debra Drive, Orlando, FL. Shortly thereafter, our client requested a change of address to 12001 Radbourne St., Winter Garden, FL. This request was definitely received by the state as evidenced by the attached notification that articles of incorporation had been filed which showed the new address. Apparently at some time shortly thereafter, the address was changed back to 2550 Lake Debra Drive without our client's consent or knowledge. Because your records are in error, our client has not received a notification to file the annual report causing the corporation to become inactive. Since this is the first time he has owned a corporation, he was unaware of the fee being due and certainly would have paid it timely had he known about it.
