ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION OF KITSON HOSPITALITY, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 607.1402 and 607.1403 of the Florida Business Corporation Act, KITSON HOSPITALITY, INC., a Florida corporation (the "Corporation"). Thereby files the following Articles of Dissolution for the purpose of dissolving the Corporation:
