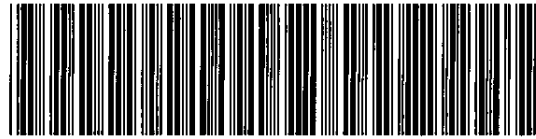

PURSUANT to the provisions of Section **607.1002** of the Florida Statutes, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendments to its Articles of Incorporation:

1. Until this amendment, the name of the corporation was

2. The following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the Stockholders of the Corporation on July 15, 2007, in the manner prescribed by the Florida General Act:

THE NAME OF THE CORPORATION IS CHANGED TO:

3. The number of shares of the Corporation outstanding at the time of such adoption was Two Hundred Million (200,000,000), and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon was One Hundred Million (100,000,000)

The amendment does not provide for an exchange, reclassification or cancellation of issued shares and does not provide for a change in the amount of stated capital.




