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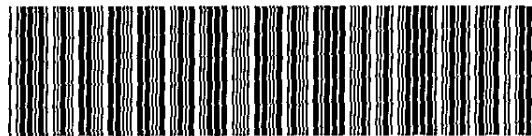



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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

**ARTICLE I - NAME**

The name of the corporation is SYKES CREEK INVESTMENT GROUP, INC.
