AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

JJSURGENT INC.

WHEREAS, the name of the composition is JISURGENT INC. The Corporation's original Cartificate of incorporation was filed with the Florida Division of Corporations on August 25, 2003.

WHEREAS, these Amended and Restated Afficials of Incorporation were duly adopted by the sole director and sole sharsholder of the Corporation on September 22, 2003 in accordance with the applicable provisions of Fiorida law.

WHEREAS, the Articles of incorporation of the Corporation are arranded and restated to read in Rall as follows:

FIRST: The name of the Corporation is LISURGENT INC. The Corporation's multing address is 20515 Linksview Drive, Soca Raton, Florida, 33434.

SECOND: The name and address of the Corporation's registered agent in the State of Florida is Corporate Creations Network Inc. located at 11350 Prosperty Farms Road, #221E, Palm Basch Gardens, Florida 33410.

THIRD: The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is to engage in any and all leavilul acts and activity for which corporations may be organized under Florida lew. The Corporation will have perpetual existence.

FOURTH: The total number of shares of stock which the Corporation shall have authority to issue in Ten Thousand (10,000) shares, par value \$.001 per share, designated Common Stock.

The designations and the powers, preferences, rights, qualifications, limitations, and restrictions of the Common Stock are as follows:

- Provisions Relating to the Common Stock.
- (a) Each share of Common Stock of the Corporation shall have identical rights and privileges in every respect. The holders of shares of Common Stock shall be entitled to vote upon all matters submitted to a vote of the stockholders of the Corporation and shall be entitled to one vote for each share of Common Stock held.
- (b) The holders of shares of the Common Stock shall be shilled to receive such dividends (payable in cash, stock, or otherwise) as may be declared thereon by the board of directors at any time and from time to time out of any funds of the Corporation legally available therefor.

(c) In the event of any voluntary or involuntary liquidation, dissolution, or winding-up of the Corporation, the holders of shares of the Common Stock shall be entitled to receive all of the remaining assets of the Corporation available for distribution to its stockholders, ratably in proportion to the number of shares of the Common Stock hold by them. A liquidation, dissolution, or winding-up of the Corporation, as such because used in this Persyraph (c), shall not be deemed to be decisioned by or to include any consolidation or marger of the Corporation with or into any other corporation or corporations or other entity or a sale, lesse, exchange, or conveyance of all or a part of the assets of the Corporation.

3. General.

- (a) Subject to the foregoing provisions of this Certificate of incorporation, the Corporation may issue shares of its Common Stock from time to time for such consideration (not less than the per value thereof) as may be fixed by the board of directors of the Corporation, which is expressly authorized to fix the same in its absolute and uncontrolled discretion. Shares so issued for which the consideration shall have been paid or desvered to the Corporation shall be deemed fully paid stock and shall not be liable to any further call or assessment thereon, and the holders of such shares shall not be liable for any further payments in respect of such shares.
- (b) The Corporation shall have authority to create and issue rights and options entiting their holders to purchase shares of the Corporation's capital stock of any class or series or other securities of the Corporation, and such rights and options shall be evidenced by instrument(s) approved by the board of directors of the Corporation. The board of directors of the Corporation shall be empowered to set the exercise price, duration, times for exercise, and other terms of such options or rights; provided, however, that the consideration to be received for any shares of capital stock subject thereto shall not be less than the par value thereof.

FIFTH: The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by the board of directors. The number of directors constituting the board of directors is one (1), and the name of the person who is to serve as director until the first annual meeting of stockholders or until his augmentar is elected and qualified is John J. Surgent.

SOUTH: Directors of the Corporation need not be ejected by written battet unless the bylaws of the Corporation otherwise provide.

SEVENTH: The directors of the Corporation shall have the power to adopt, amend, and receal the bylaws of the Corporation.

EIGHTH: No contract or transaction between the Corporation and one or more of its directors, officers, or stockholders or between the Corporation and any person (as used herein "person" mesme other corporation, partnership, association, firm, trust, joint venture, political subdivision, or instrumentality) or other organization in which one or more of its directors, officers, or stockholders are directors, officers, or stockholders are directors, officers, or stockholders, or have a financial interest, shall be void or voidable solely for such reason, or solely because the director or officer is present at or participates in the meeting of the board or committee which suthorizes the contract or transaction, or solely because his, her, or their voice are counted for such purpose. Common or interested directors may be counted in determining the presence of a quorum at a meeting of the board of directors or of a committee which authorizes the contract or transaction.

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MINTH: The Corporation shall indemnify any person who was, is, or is threatened to be made a party to a proceeding (as hereination defined) by reason of the fact that he or she (i) is or was a director or officer of the Corporation or (ii) while a director or officer of the Corporation, is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as a director, officer, pariner, venturer, proprietor, trustee, employee, agent, or similar functionary of another foreign or domestic corporation, partnership, loist venture, sole proprietorship, trust, employee benefit plan, or other enterprise, to the fullest extent permitted under Florida law, se the same exists or may hereafter be simentiad. Such right shall be a contract right and as such shall run to the benefit of any director or officer who is elected and accepts the position of director or officer of the Corporation or elects to continue to serve as a director or officer of the Corporation while this Article is in effect. Any repeal or amendment of this Article shall be prospective only and shall not limit the rights of any such director or officer or the obligations of the Corporation with respect to any claim arising from or related to the services of such director or officer in any of the foregoing capacities prior to any such repeal or emendment to this Article. Such right shall include the right to be paid by the Corporation expenses incurred in datending any such proceeding in advance of its final disposition to the meximum extent plermitted under Florida law, as the same tedats or may hereafter be amended. If a claim for indemnification or advancement of supenses hereunder is not paid in full by the Corporation within shity (60) days after a written claim has been received by the Corporation, the claiment may at any time thereafter bring sull against the Corporation to recover the unpaid amount of the claim, and if successful in whole or in part, the deliment shall also be entitled to be paid the expenses of prosecuting such claim. It shall be a detense to any such action that such indemnification or advancement of costs of defense are not permitted under Florida law, but the burden of proving such defense shall be on the Corporation. Neither the fallure of the Corporation (including its board of directors or say committee thereof, independent legal counsel, or slockholders) to have made its determination prior to the commencement of such action that indemnification of, or advancement of posts of defense to, the claimant is permissible in the circumstances nor an actual determination by the Corporation (including its board of directors or any committee thereof, independent legal counsel, or atocknoiders) that such indemnification or advancement is not permissible shell be a defense to the action or create a presumption that such indemnification or advancement is not permissible. In the event of the death of any person having a right of indemnification under the foregoing provisions, such right shall incre to the benefit of his or har heirs, executors, administrators, and personal representatives. The rights conferred above shall not be exclusive of any other right which any person may have or hereafter acquire under any statute, by law, resolution of stockholders or directors, earesment, or otherwise.

The Corporation may additionally indemnify any employee or agent of the Corporation to the fullest extent permitted by law.

As used herein, the term "proceeding" means any threatened, pending, or completed action, sult, or proceeding, whether civil, orlininal, administrative, arbitrative, or investigative, any appeal in such an action, sult, or proceeding, and any inquiry or investigation that could lead to such an action, sult, or proceeding.

TENTH: A director of the Corporation shall not be personally liable to the Corporation or its stockholders for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a director, except for liability (I) for any breach of the director's duty of loyalty to the Corporation or its stockholders, (II) for some or ordiseless not in good faith or which

involve intentional misconduct or knowing violation of law or (iii) for any transaction from which the director derived an improper personal benefit. Any raped or amondment of this Article by the stockholders of the Corporation shall be prospective only, and shall not adversely effect any limitation on the personal liability of a director of the Corporation enliquing from an act or emission occurring prior to the time of such repeat or amandment. In addition to the circumstances in which a director of the Corporation is not personally liable as set forth in the foregoing provisions of this Article, a director shall not be liable to the Corporation or its stockholders to such further extent as permitted by any law hereafter enacted, including without limitation any subsequent amendment to Florida law.
