ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE DELPORTE DISCIPLINE, INC.

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The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the provision FARY OF STATE Chapter 607, Fla. Stat., the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby states the following SEE FLORIDA

ARTICLE I - NAME AND ADDRESS

Section 1. The name of the Corporation shall be The Delporte Discipline, Inc.

Section 2. The principal office and the initial mailing address of the Corporation shall be Suite 408, 3444 East Lake Road, Palm Harbor, Florida 34685.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence beginning on the date these Articles are filed with the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE AND POWERS

Section 1. The Corporation is formed for the purpose of engaging in any lawful activity or business for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida.
