ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopted the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is, HOUSE OF GLORY, INC.

ARTICLE II - TERM OF EXISTENCE

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III - NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation is organized for the purpose of offering Nursing Assistance Services to children and adult with disabilities and doing business as permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV - AUTHORIZED SHARES

The aggregate number of shares that the corporation shall have the authority to issue is 10,000 shares of capital stock for the par value of \$0.01 per share, the sum of \$100.00, the par value of all of capital stock for the corporation that have been issued, shall be stated capital of the corporation at any particular time. 
ARTICLE X - CUMULATIVE VOTE

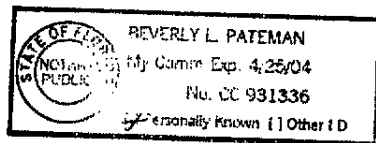
