ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of NEED-A-STITCH EMBROIDERY, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME and PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The name of this corporation is NEED-A-STITCH EMBROIDERY, INC., and its principal place of business shall be located at 265-B. Azalea Drive, Destin, Florida 3,541.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing on the date of this filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

This corporation is initially organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under Florida Statutes.
