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Articles of Incorporation of A Coleman Enterprises Inc.

The undersigned, for the purpose of becoming a corporation for profit under the Laws of the state of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

Article I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be A Coleman Enterprises Inc..

Article II – Principal Place and Mailing Address

The principal place of business is 1940 C.R. 393 North, Santa Rosa Beach, Florida 32459. Mailing address is Post Office Box 2455 Santa Rosa Beach, Florida 32459

Article III - Duration

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

Article IV – Purpose

This shall be a general-purpose corporation. It's goals and purposes shall be determined by its directors. The corporation may hire employees as may be necessary or desirable to accomplish it's purpose, and may hold such licenses as necessary or convenient for the corporate purposes. Additionally, the corporation shall be entitled to enter into contracts of every nature to own real or personal property, to borrow money, and to do all other things necessary or convenient by the State of Florida.

Every share holder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation of the same kind, class or series as that which he already holds, shall have the right to purchase his prorate share there of (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at market value.

Article VIII - Initial Board of Directors

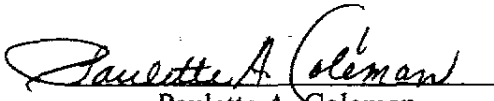
