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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

SECRETARY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE. FLORIDA

OF

The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, natural persons competent to contract, hereby form a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is MILLENIUM ENTERPRISES OF LONGWOOD, INC.

ARTICLE II - NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general character or nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is as follows:
