ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of this corporation is ALAN LINDSEY ROOFING, INC.

ARTICLE II - Duration

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

This corporation is authorized to issue 7,500 shares of One Dollar (\$1.00) par value common stock.


ARTICLE V - Initial Principal Office
