ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ARTICLE I

NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of this corporation is PICTURE WAREHOUSE EAST, INC. and its principal address is 15495 Tamiami Trail North, Suite 121, Naples, Florida 34110.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually commencing on the date of execution of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

BY-LAWS

AMENDMENT

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment to them by a two-thirds vote of the shareholders.


