ARTICLES OF INCORPORATIOND3 DEC -8 PH 6: 00 SUNCOAST P.E.D., INC.

The undersigned, for the purposes of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE: NAME

The name of the Corporation is SUNCOAST P.E.D., INC. The principal address is 6523 Brandon Drive, New Port Richey, Florida 34652.

ARTICLE TWO: TERM OF EXISTENCE

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual. Corporate existence is to commence on the date of filing of the Articles of Incorporation by the Secretary of State.


